Job Description:

Francis Parker School seeks a qualified Spanish Instructor. This position requires a 5-week commitment (6/28/2021 – 8/6/2021, 8:30 am-3:30 pm) and (8/9/2021-8/20/2021, 8:30 am-12:30 pm), in addition to a mandatory training session on Saturday 6/5/2021 or 6/12/2021. **Must be available for on-boarding no later than 6/1/21.**

Essential Duties/Responsibilities:

- Develop lesson plans and supplementary materials to teach *Practice Spanish Skills, Spanish I and II Intensive, and Spanish Pre-AP Language and Culture.*
- Teach curricula aligned to standards along with social and emotional skills
- Assess and analyze students' performance and progress to ensure they are mastering developmental skills regularly, and responding to data to support all scholars to achieve academic success
- Supervise a group of children, promoting a positive environment that fosters fun, safety, and Parker values.
- Uphold, model and enforce summer program policies.
- Maintain safety and cleanliness standards.
- Follow Parker's policies and procedures, including those related to medical and disciplinary situations, child abuse prevention, and emergencies.
- Maintain positive relations with parents and other staff.

- Advanced language proficiency or native Spanish speaker
- Teaching experience required
